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





(After Morgan & Shaffer 1966)











MAP 4⁵ DISTRIBUTION OF LUO "TRIBES" and TERRITORIAL DIVISIONS





MAP 4³ DISTRIBUTION OF MJI KENDA BANTU






MAP 4 DISTRIBUTION OF CENTRAL BANTU












