


Fig. 1. Finds From Castlehill. (1/2)






Fig. 2. Finds From Lochlee. ($\frac{1}{2}$)






Fig. 3. Querns From Lochlee. ($\frac{1}{8}$) A.W.




Fig. 4. Finds From Ayrshire Sites. ($\frac{1}{2}$) A.W.







Fig. 5. Finds From Ayrshire. ($\frac{1}{2}$) A.W.
